I am sharing a little artifact of history. This is copy of an amendment to our original articles of incorporation filed October 11, 1965. It is our agency's 60th anniversary.

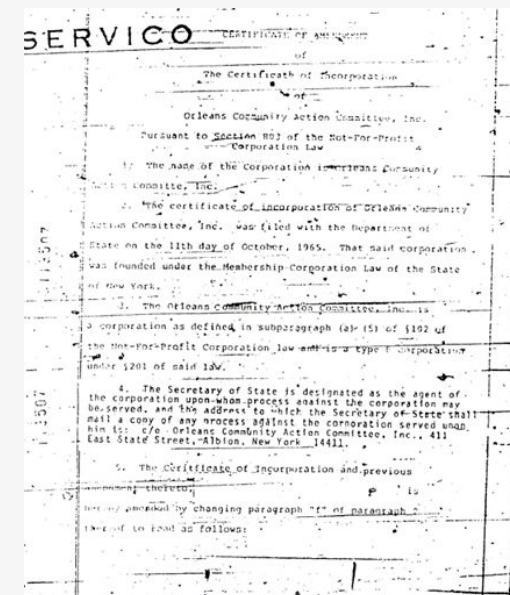
